HOW TO USE THIS CALENDAR IN DEVOTIONAL TIME:

Start off by asking God to help align your thoughts & your ways with His. Read a Bible passage (either a chapter, a reading plan, or other devotional guide). Write some thoughts that came to mind as you read (principles to apply, perspectives to change, sin to confess, people to encourage, etc.). Speak to God about what you've written...

1
Pray for local ministries and organizations. Pray for wisdom, provision, and blessing as they seek to help those in need.

2
Pray for those who write our laws and those who enforce them. Pray they would act in ways that are above reproach and uphold justice.

3
Pray for those who are struggling with infertility.

4
Ask God to prepare the hearts of those who attend the Easter services. Pray He would remove stumbling blocks and grow in them a spiritual hunger.

5
"He is not here; he has risen!" (Luke 24:6-7) Praise God for the eternal hope we have through the death and resurrection of Jesus!

6
Pray that those who attended on Easter would experience life change and continue to grow in their walk with Christ.

7
Pray that your leaders in all areas would walk uprightly. Ask God to give them strength in their daily fight against sin and help them lead with humility, love, patience, and gentleness.

8
Pray for campus ministries as they reach college students. Pray for good connections, open hearts, and spiritual growth.

9
Pray that our city's culture would increasingly value and protect the lives of the unborn.

10
Pray for the workers who make deliveries (mail, food, packages, etc.). Pray for their protection and blessing.

11
Ask God to protect you from becoming too inward-focused. Pray instead that you would be spurring one another on towards love and good deeds (Heb 10:24).

12
Pray that God would grow in each of us a deeper appreciation of His holiness and a greater reverence towards Him.

13
Pray the Holy Spirit would awaken the ability for Christ-followers to discern truth from error in every area of life.

14
Pray for wisdom, protection, humility, and integrity for our city, state, and national leaders.

15
Pray that God would increase the impact of our local, national, and international ministry partners.

16
Pray that the media would produce content that is truthful--not fake, embellished, or biased. Pray for God to help you be a discerning consumer of it.

17
Pray that God would strengthen marriages and families.

18
Pray for safety (and cooler weather) during the Trinity River Trash Bash! Pray for opportunities to connect with the people of Fort Worth.

19
Pray that God would protect and grow the unity of Hope Church and help us team together well as we seek to honor Him.

20
Pray for protection, boldness, and encouragement for Christ-followers facing persecution here and in other countries.

21
Pray for health, protection, and blessing for the staff, leaders, members, and attenders of Hope Church.

22
Pray for the Cornerstone Assistance Network - for provision, protection, and blessing for their workers and those who come through the doors.

In the face of all that is unknown, keep coming back to what IS known: **God is good.** Thank Him for His generosity, demonstrated mostly clearly in the gift of His son!

24
Pray God would bring a God-honoring spouse for those who desire to be married.

Pray that God would help you use your words to build others up - not tear them down.

Pray that Hope Church will remain steadfast in holding to what the Bible says is right and wise. (Psalm 19:9)

Pray for those in our community who don't know Jesus. Pray for opportunities to identify with Christ and make an invitation.

Pray for the protection and blessing of our first responders and their families.

Pray for our national and international ministry partners. Pray for their protection, encouragement, provision, and connection.

Pray that truth and righteousness will prevail in our country and that our leaders would seek to honor God in all they do.
