HOW TO USE THIS CALENDAR IN YOUR DEVOTIONAL TIME: Start off by asking God to help align your thoughts & your ways with His. Read a Bible passage (either a chapter, a reading plan, or other devotional guide). Write some thoughts that came to mind as you read (principles to apply, perspectives to change, sin to confess, people to encourage, etc.). Speak to God about what you've written down, thanking Him for listening to you and making a way for you to know Him. Take the daily prompt on this calendar to bring before God as well. Make plans to also use this calendar as a tool in family prayer times.

Pray that God would root out your arrogance and grow you in kindness and humility.

2
Pray that God would use Hope Church to bless others in our community and allow us the opportunity to tell them about Jesus.

3
Pray that as not-yet Christ followers see God's people treating them with love and compassion, they'd be drawn to our compassionate, loving God.

4
Pray for health, protection, and blessing for the staff, leaders, members, and attenders of Hope Church.

5
Pray that God would increase the impact of our local, national, and international ministry partners.

6
In the face of all that is unknown, keep coming back to what IS known: **God is good**. Thank Him for His generosity, demonstrated mostly clearly in the gift of His son!

7
Pray God would bring a God-honoring spouse for those who desire to be married.

8
Ask God to show you how He wants to make you more like Christ.

9
Pray that God would grow in each of us a deeper appreciation of His holiness and a greater reverence towards Him.

10
Praise God for the freedom we have and for the lives and the sacrifice of those who have, and continue to, protect it.

11
Pray that your leaders in all areas would walk uprightly. Ask God to give them strength in their daily fight against sin and help them lead with humility, love, patience, and gentleness.

12
Pray for organizations helping those in need. Pray God would provide necessary resources and that their workers would be blessed.

13
Pray and ask God to raise up more workers with different gifts across Fort Worth.

14
Pray that God would strengthen marriages and families.

15
Tell God what you're discontented about and ask Him to help you see things from an eternal perspective.

16
Pray for the 2025 Christmas Offering - that God would help us reach our goal and use it in a mighty way to draw people closer to Him through our ministry partners.

17
Pray the Holy Spirit would awaken the ability for Christ-followers to discern truth from error in every area of life.

18
Pray for the protection and blessing of our first responders and their families.

19
Pray for the Fort Worth Pregnancy Center - for provision, protection, and wisdom. Pray those who come through their doors would be blessed and draw closer to God.

20
Pray that God would strengthen young people against the temptations they currently face. Pray especially for resolve to pursue purity.

21
Pray for those who are struggling with infertility.

22
Ask God to help you do good today. Pray for wisdom in setting the right priorities and for self-control to avoid distractions.

23
Pray that older members of our congregation would feel increasingly loved and valued as spiritual fathers and mothers in the family of God.

24
Pray that the homes of people around you will be marked by unity and peace rather than arguments and disputes.

25
Pray for wisdom, protection, humility, and integrity for our city, state, and national leaders.

26
Pray for our national and international ministry partners. Pray for their protection, encouragement, provision, and connection.

27
"Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise! Give thanks to Him; bless His name!" (Psalm 100:4)

28
Pray for those with loved ones in prison. Pray that God would give them hope.

29
Ask God to help you be a discerning consumer of media, able to wisely distinguish truth from falsehood and fact from opinion.

Pray that those who are less-connected in church life would come to see the essential role they can play.
