HOW TO USE THIS CALENDAR IN YOUR DEVOTIONAL TIME:

Start off by asking God to help align your thoughts and your ways with His. Read a Bible passage (either a chapter, a reading plan, or other devotional guide). Write some thoughts that came to mind as you read (principles to apply, perspectives to change, sin to confess, people to encourage, etc.). Speak to God about what you've written down, thanking Him for listening to you and making a way for you to know Him. Take the daily prompt on this calendar to bring before God as well. Make plans to also use this calendar as a tool in family prayer times.

1
Pray for those with loved ones in prison. Pray that God would give them hope.

2
Ask God to help you pray confidently for the needs of the nation, knowing that He is able and willing to intervene. (Proverbs 15:3)

3
Pray that God would protect the unity of Hope Church and help us team together well as we seek to honor Him.

4
Pray that truth and righteousness will prevail in our country and that our leaders would seek to honor God in all they do.

5
Pray for peace, protection, and integrity--and praise God for He is faithful, just, and upright! (Deuteronomy 32:3-4)

6
Remember that God is good and thank Him for the way that He, in his sovereignty, weaves together all things to glorify His Son.

7
Pray that this would not be a time when evil is able to flourish or the weak oppressed, but that God would work through human agents to uphold justice.

8
Pray specifically for the schools around you and for any teachers you know.

9
Ask God to grow in you an attitude of generosity and thankfulness.

10
Pray that God would use Hope Church to bless others in our community and allow us the opportunity to tell them about Jesus.

11
Praise God for the freedom we have and for the lives and the sacrifice of those who have, and continue to, protect it.

12
Pray for health, protection, encouragement, and safety for the Hope Deacons and their families.

13
Pray for local ministries and organizations. Pray for wisdom, provision, and blessing as they seek to help those in need.

14
Pray for those who write our laws and those who enforce them. Pray they would act in ways that are above reproach and uphold justice.

15
Pray for those who are looking for work or facing financial difficulties.

16
Ask God to show you a helpful way forward in a situation where you feel stuck.

17
Pray for the 2024 Christmas Offering - that God would help us reach our goal and use it in a mighty way to draw people closer to Him through our ministry partners.

18
Pray by name for any believers you know who are struggling spiritually. Ask God to strengthen their faith and help them endure.

19
Pray for health, protection, encouragement, and safety for the Hope Staff and their families.

20
Pray for our national ministry partners. Pray for their protection, encouragement, provision, and connection.

21
Pray and thank God for the people of Fort Worth and its unique culture. Pray those moving here would find godly friends and community.

22
Pray for the workers who make deliveries (mail, food, packages, etc.). Pray they will be blessed.

23
Pray that God would give you clarity on where you need more truth in your life.

24
Pray that the Thanksgiving Party would be a delightful and welcoming experience where good connections are made.

25
Pray for protection, boldness, and encouragement for Christ-followers facing persecution here and in other countries.

26
Pray that your leaders would walk uprightly. Ask God to give them strength in their daily fight against sin and help them lead with humility, love, patience, and gentleness.

27
Pray for our international ministry partners. Pray for their protection, encouragement, provision, and connection.

28
"I will give thanks to the Lord because of his righteousness; I will sing the praises of the name of the Lord Most High." - Psalm 7:17

Pray God would bring a God-honoring spouse for those who desire to be married and that He would strengthen marriages and families.

Ask God to help you be patient with others this week and to be gracious and grateful in your words and attitude.
